Feast day of St. Francis of Assisi

St. Francis (1182- 1226) was born and died in Assisi. He was the son of a rich merchant, Bernardone, received a good education, and in the beginning followed the ways of the world. He was taken prisoner in the battle between the Assisians and Perugians, after his release decided to abandon everything for Christ. His father became extremely displeased at his action, and disinherited him. In 1220 he founded new order which in 10 years numbered 5000 brothers. His followers were called Friars Minor because they were to consider themselves the least among religious. Out of humility Francis never accepted the priesthood but remained a deacon all his life. He had a great love for God's creatures and called them his brothers and sisters. His ardent love of God merited for him the name of Seraphic. This feast is celebrated October 4th both in the Ordinary Form and the Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite.
