The Father Saylor Council 3774 would like to invite you to the 51^{st} K.C.I.A.G.A. to be held in the beautiful state of Michigan from Sunday June 9^{th} thru Friday June 14^{th} . We have 3 challenging yet fair golf courses reserved as well as fellowship events planned for your week.

Registration for play will occur at the "Host" hotel Sunday thru Tuesday, scheduled hours are Sunday 12 noon until 5:00 pm, Monday and Tuesday 10 am until 4 pm.

The golf schedule starts with an 8:00 am shotgun start 4-Man Scramble on Wednesday at Lakes of Taylor. Individual play on Thursday will be at Taylor Meadows in Taylor and Links at Gateway in Romulus on Friday. Both courses will also have an 8:00 A.M. start time. The 3 courses will be open for practice rounds starting on Saturday, contact each course directly for tee times and reduced rates.

For those of you who sign up for transportation it will be provided from Wednesday through Friday to the golf courses and to the events at our Council Hall. Note: There will be special transportation provided from the hotel to our Council for the Steak Dinner and Casino Trip.

Monday, our Council will host a "you grill it" Steak Dinner at our Lounge. If you plan to attend, please indicate so on the entry form so we can have enough food on hand to feed everyone - the cost is \$12.00 per person.

On Tuesday we will have a Casino trip planned and sponsored by our M.I. Committee. The buses will leave at 10:00 A.M. from our Lounge and return approximately 5:00 pm. You will receive Casino cash and food vouchers when arriving at the casino. Upon your return there will be a light meal served at our Council Lounge - all of this is included for the price of the trip, which is \$40.00.

We have three evening events planned for the week a Welcome Social on Wednesday, Pasta Dinner on Thursday and the Awards Banquet on Friday; all these events will have a cash bar and held at our Council Hall.

To be in good standing for this tournament, your dues must be paid through December 31st, of the current year tournament year.
- 3. The 2-Day Entry Fee includes 18-Hole Green Fee's w/cart for Thursday and Friday of the tournament and the Wednesday, Thursday and Friday night social events.
- 4. The Wednesday Men's Scramble Fee includes 18-Hole Green Fee w/cart and prize money.
- The Thursday Ladies Golf Fee includes 18-Hole Green Fee w/cart. (Note: This event requires a
 minimum of 20 entries to be held. You may be contacted prior to the tournament to inform you of
 the events status).
- 6. Wives, Adult Guest, Non-Golfers and Children 13 Socials/Banquet Fee includes the Wednesday, Thursday and Friday social events. Children 12 and under Fee includes the Wednesday, Thursday and Friday social events at a reduced rate.
