THIS MAN OF GOD

In the year 1958 there was a new beginning in a small town in the thumb of Michigan, A young man was born to serve us all. He came from a farm community of large families and deep faith in their catholic beliefs. How do I know this well I just happened to live nearby. This young man was like many we all know, a farm boy with chores and a dream of the future. After graduating from high school his desire to serve god's people led him to enroll in St. Meinrad College in St. Meinrad, Indiana, where he received his bachelor's degree and he continued his preparation for priest hood in the Catholic Church.

He graduated with a masters of divinity degree in 1985 from St. Johns Provincial Seminary.

Father Dennis Kucharczyk was ordained a priest on October 21^s. 1985 for the Diocese of Saginaw. I first met him in 1986 after he joined the Knights of Columbus in Saginaw Michigan at St. Peter & Paul Catholic Church where he was serving his first assignment.

After serving at St. Anne parish in Linwood, Michigan he moved on to Blessed Sacrament Parish in Midland Michigan. In 1993 he served at St. Roch's Parish in Caseville and then to Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Caro in the year 2001.

All of this did not happen automatically, it happens with experience and understanding human nature, its behavior and problems of the people he must serve. It was in the middle of this venture for God's people that Father Dennis took on his continual education of life to serve with the department of Public Safety for the Midland County Sheriff's Dept. where he graduated from Delta College Police Academy. He then returned to active ministry as pastor of St.Roch's in Caseville in 1993. This was when he said "quote" my gift is serving my vocation in life as a priest and this is where I will be!

Father Dennis has had three uniforms that of a priest, police officer and navy chaplain, he has served his country as a Lt. Commander USNR. We truly have a man of experience and dedication with service to God, Country and the Knights of Columbus.

As difficult as things maybe today, we see things in a positive light. After traveling from Coast to Coast and attending mass in many parishes we at Sacred Heart have been given a special gift with the involvement of our young people thanks to Father Dennis and his group of helpers. I would be remiss if I did not mention his talent with our young ones, for they are the future of the Catholic Church. What you and I do is left up to us to be in heaven. We need to support this man of God in his vocation as he may be sent to a future challenge someday. Father Dennis is our Knights of Columbus Chaplain of Council 3224.
