They had projects like papering the Ladies and Men restrooms. They also purchased the first two stoves for the new hall. We are a family organization that works together to make our church succeed, in these trouble times, to understand why we must work together is easy to see. The ladies had masses said for our deceased ones and were leaders in many ways of the church.
