

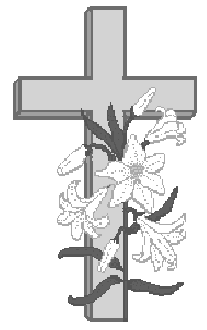

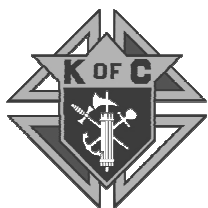

We have sent out a letter asking you for donations to the building fund again this year which you should be receiving soon. We hope that you will reflect on the past year and the improvements the board has made to the building and help us going forward.
