# MEMBER DICK THELEN HONORED IN CEREMONY

On Monday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>, U.S. Rep. Elissa Slotkin, D-Holly, honored Dick Thelen at an event held at the Grace Lutheran Church attended by his friends and family, and Lansing Mayor Andy Schor. It was declared Richard Thelen Day in Lansing. Three Lansing-area lawmakers read tributes, and Representative Slotkin gave him a U.S. flag that had been flown over the U.S. Capitol. Dick is the last Michigan survivor of the sinking of the USS Indianapolis, and one of only 11 men living left who survived the disaster.

President Donald Trump signed the "USS Indianapolis Congressional Gold Medal Act" a year ago, honoring the entire crew, though the medal hasn't yet been presented to an Indianapolis museum, where it's expected to be housed. Out of nearly 1,200 men, only 317 would live to tell the harrowing tale of five days adrift in the Philippine Sea. About 300 men went down with the ship; nearly 600 others died from shark attacks, injuries, dehydration or salt poisoning from drinking salt water. Dick has said he was drenched in diesel fuel, which may have kept the sharks from attacking him.

Thelen, who had a career as a truck driver, didn't talk about his experience for years. He married in 1951 but didn't tell his wife, JoAnne, for seven years about his experience. The couple had six children. Five of them attended Monday's ceremony (daughter JoAnne died in 2002). Thelen said he doesn't like being called a "hero", however Representative Slotkin suggested that's the true definition of a hero. "Thank you for being an example of what a true patriot means to us. We need that more than ever these days," she said

Also note that in addition to your dues, the option is available to donate additional contributions to any or all of the following:






