## Grand Knights Message Jay G. Corey

As I write my last message as your Grand Knight, and last issue as the Newsletter Editor, I want to thank everyone for this truly great experience and for allowing me to be a part of the legacy of Council #788. It has been quite an experience since I joined the Knights 19 years ago this coming October. I thank the late John Powers for sponsoring me in, and together with the late R. Jay Kussmaul, got me involved with the LCA and our council and the Knights of Columbus.

It's hard to believe that 24 months have passed so quickly, though less than half a dozen members probably thought it was 14 dog years. The critics, boo birds, garage and back yard conversation fests, gloom and doom boys, and all the other adjectives, are only a memory and were non-effective to the progress that our council has made in the last 24 months.

Our council now is stronger financially than it has ever been since I became a Knight, and our LCA is in the same condition, thanks to our LCA President Bill Schaner. Never in 19 years have both of these entities been in the same condition at the same time. Both Bill and I thank you the members, Officers, LCA Board, and Trustees of the Council for making this all happen. We both have money in savings, our bills are paid, and thanks to a Building Fund request to the membership, have monies available for on-going repairs to our building without at this time having to go to financial institutions for support.

My officers and I inherited a financially sound council in July of 2017 and have been able to build on it ever since, increasing our membership this fraternal year by 40% of our goal, despite losing many members to attrition. I attended the Big Man For Christ program in February 2017 and happened to sit with Bill Schaner. He and I talked and he agreed to take over the vacant position of LCA President at the time to which I appointed him to. This has led to a great friendship both personal and business and together we went "outside the box" and found Monica Bergstrom who became our Club Manager. Monica and her great enthusiasm and cooking skills has brought much to our council hall and I thank her and her husband Drew for all of their help and promotion of Council #788 and Columbus Hall.

I am proud to say that Council #788 is one of the best councils in the State of Michigan, and you the membership made this happen. In my first meeting with my officers in July of 2017 we created our Mission Statement which is on our entrance bulletin board. My pledge to those officers and the membership in July 2017 was to continue to keep Council #788 on a forward path and always put our council first. Mission Accomplished. We have continued that quest always completing the requirements imposed by Supreme and State on forms and requests in a timely manner. Our officers attended every meeting in the District and we have always tried to comply with programs introduced. I am also proud to have worked with such a great group of officers the last 24 months.

I welcome Corey Livingston who will be our next Grand Knight. I have pledged to Corey any assistance that he needs but will do it from the wings of the stage. Corey and his officers are set to continue the progress of our council and I know he and his wife Alana will do a great job, as will his officer corp. I also welcome your new Newsletter Editor Dave Schulte to our Council #788 staff. Dave is eager to get started and you can find information to contact Dave elsewhere in this newsletter.

I ask that you continue to support our many programs, events, officers, and LCA, throughout this next year as I will also continue to do. Again, *Thank you*, *Jay*

Over the last 28 months I have heard from many of the members. A lot of you were very complimentary with your comments, thanking me for the hard work, of course I was not alone in running the events around the club, I had the whole board behind me. For those members who voiced their displeasure with the direction the LCA board was heading I want you to know I listened to all your comments. I tried to separate the rhetoric from your message to understand your concerns and tried to incorporate any good ideas into the direction the board was heading.

A HUGE thank you to all the board members, past and present, who I served with over the last 28 months. Being part of this great board has been very rewarding, we had some great times working the events together and working to make the club a better place. I had the greatest board anyone could ask to work with for my term and I feel we have made some great strides. I was able to serve with many great board members, some of whom would work the front lines, or work in the kitchen, or work the administrative tasks or work doing repairs around the club. Also, I had a great club manager in Monica Bergstrom, who has become part of the Council family.

Now is time for the next set of members to step up and lead the club. The LCA board is looking for new board members, we have our annual meeting in July where we will hold our elections, and we have some openings on the board. This is a very rewarding experience and you get to work with a great group of brother Knights. Contact Jay Corey, Corey Livingston or myself for information on becoming a board member.




