Thanks to everyone who attended our February comedy night, it was a great success. There were two comedians who provided lots of laughs and we had a great meal prepared by Monica Bergstrom with her great cooking and catering skills. Thanks to everyone who attended and helped support the Club.

We also had a great Craft Beer Tasting in January run by Chairman Ron Cook, who was able to sell the event out. It was great to have a full room of people enjoying quality craft beers, thanks to Ron for putting the effort into this event and selling it out.

We have our Fat Tuesday Dinner coming up on Tuesday March 5<sup>th</sup> chaired by Rich Rybicki. Rich received great compliments from last year's dinner, and he and his team are preparing another great meal with homemade kielbasa, kapusta (sauerkraut), golabki (cabbage rolls), city chicken, potatoes with gravy & paczkis from Roma's Bakery. It is only \$12 per person, so come out and enjoy a great meal at the club to kick off Lent. The event runs from 4 pm to 7 pm so get there early to enjoy all the food.

Speaking of Lent, it is right around the corner which means the fish frys are back at the club every Friday in Lent from March 9<sup>th</sup> to and including Good Friday from 4 pm to 7 pm. We will be serving baked and fried pollock, fried smelt, baked potatoes, french fries, macaroni and cheese, coleslaw, rolls and cheese pizza for children. The cost is only \$11.00 with an Early Bird price of \$10.00 from 4 pm to 5 pm for adults; \$5.00 for children 5-12; children under 5 eat free. And of course, the Ladies Auxiliary will have desserts available for purchase. Thanks to the Ladies Auxiliary for their support on this event and thanks to PGK Ken Morrison and PGK Mike Schaefer for chairing this event.

The LCA Board has been working hard to control costs and raise money to keep up with the maintenance and repairs on the Club. Lately, the Board has faced challenges with our equipment. We had to replace the convection oven and a fryer, both had failed, and with our fish frys around the corner we needed a full functioning kitchen. Fortunately, we were able to pay cash for these items, but we have depleted our building fund. We will be running our annual building fund campaign again this year to replenish the fund.

Last year, with your very generous donations to our building fund, we were able to eliminate our debt, recoat the parking lot, upgrade the lights in the building and in the parking lot to LED, repair the lighting outside the building, replace the convection oven, replace a fryer and we have plans for replacing the outside doors, upgrading the camera and security system this Spring. Again, your LCA board is asking that you join us in making the Club a better place by donating to the Building Fund. We will be sending out a letter asking you for donations, we hope that you reflect on the past year and help us going forward. Our building needs repairs and upgrades from the building roof, to the HVAC system, to the outside and more. Look for your letter to arrive soon.
