We hope that you reflect on the past year and the improvements the board has made to the building and help us going forward. Our building needs repairs and upgrades from the building roof, to the HVAC system, to the outside and more. Please consider donating to the fund.

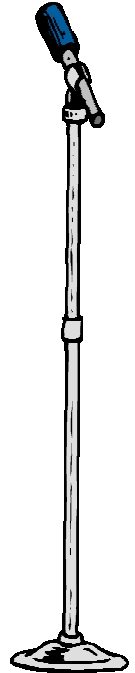
