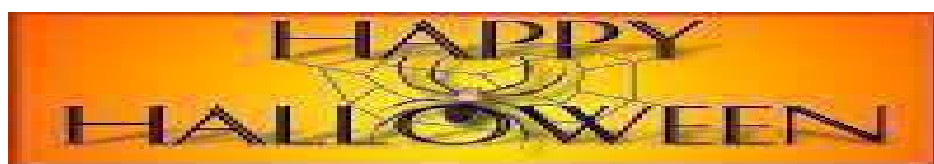

I am writing this the day after the LCA Board meeting on September 19th and I am pleased to announce that the Board voted to pay off the last of the debt on the Columbus Hall. As many of you know the Club had a line of credit to pay for some improvements for the building and updating the septic system. The LCA Board has worked hard at cutting back expenses and increasing our fundraising and we were able to pay off the debt ahead of schedule by making double, triple and quadruple payments and now we are debt free for the first time in years.

Thanks to everyone who came out to the Annual Columbus Hall Car Show. The event was a huge success raising over \$3,000 and is part of the reason for us being to pay off the debt early. And thanks to the Council members who took the time to attend the event and to talk with the car show participants answering all their questions about the Knights of Columbus. This is always a great chance to let people know who we are and what we do in the community. There are some great pictures on our Facebook page, so go to our page and view them.


The LCA is selling Cash Bash tickets at the club. The 1st ticket drawn wins \$50, the 25th ticket and every 25th ticket from 25 to 275 wins \$50. 

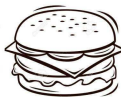
