With September upon us there will be no shortage of events to attend or opportunities for Knights and their families to volunteer and help out. First and foremost I would like to remind all members and their families and encourage you to come to our faith-based social meeting that will be taking place on Tuesday, September 3rd, at 6:00 PM. On Friday the 13th we will be hosting our first walleye dinner of the year, followed by the LCA car show on Saturday the 14th. The annual parish picnic at St. Gerard takes place on Sunday the 15th. 

Richard (pronounced rish-ARD) Council 788 was chartered on May 30, 1903 by the National Council (now the Supreme Council) of the Knights of Columbus. Our council was called the Lansing Council and drew members from the central counties of Michigan. It is believed to have been between 1910 and 1915, on the suggestion of Father F. A. O'Connor, assistant to the Pastor at St. Mary Church (St. Mary Church was raised to the dignity of Cathedral in 1937 as the Holy See Canonically erected the Diocese of Lansing), that the name "Richard Council" was adopted in honor of Fr. Gabriel Richard.

Who was this priest that Fr. O'Connor suggested that our council be named after? For the next few months Fr. Richard's biography will be listed here so our members and families can have an appreciation of our namesake.

Priest, pioneer, patriot, civic leader, publisher, teacher, congressman, arts patron... Father Gabriel Richard could claim all these titles and more, as one of the most important figures in the building of Detroit in the early 1800s. Among his accomplishments are:

- He was considered the "second founder" of Detroit.
- He was the first priest to serve in the U.S. Congress.
- He gave Detroit its first library.
- He brought first printing press west of the Alleghenies to Detroit.
- He published Detroit's first newspaper.
- He co-founded the forerunner of the University of Michigan.
- He helped Michigan get its first good road from Detroit to Chicago.
- He co-founded the Michigan Historical Society.

Born on Oct. 15, 1767, in France, Gabriel Richard came from a cultured background. His father was a clerk in the French Marine Department and saw to it that Gabriel had a fine education. Before his ordination as a Sulpician priest, he had taught mathematics at the seminary, and had it not been for the French Revolution, he might have spent his life there. But the head of his order feared for the life of the priests and sent him to the "New World" in 1791, where he served in the missions of Illinois for six years before coming to Detroit.






