



Rosaries for New Members!

"PRAY THE ROSARY DAILY"

Here are some shocking statistics for you to consider:

- 4 out of every 10 who marry can expect to be divorced eventually.
- Among those who stay married, hundreds of thousands live in discord, bitterness and alleration. Many are beset by problems of alcoholism, drugs, infidelity, mental illness and poverty.
- · Nearly 1 million youngsters run away from their families each year.
- e At least 11/2 million logal abortions are performed annually.

From these statistics, it would seem that the "family" is fast becoming an endangered species


Supreme Knight Virgil C. Dechant has recognized the deterioration of family life and stated, when accepting the position of supreme knight, that our Order will "take the initiative in protecting and furthering the Christian values which currently are being threatened with extinction by monumental waves of materialism and secular humanism."

The philosophy which he expressed is being implemented in the "SEARCH '78" program which calls for special emphasis on strengthening family life and immediate attention to the current crisis in vecations. Supreme Knight Dechant firmly believes that if vocations are to come from our young, they must be stimulated and nourished in the atmosphere of our homes. Father Peyton's slagan, "The family that prays together stays together," seems most timely and appropriate is this early phase of our "SEARCH '78" program.

"Pray the resary every day" was the advice given by Our Lady to the children at Fatima. To promote more frequent use at the resery, each meinber who is enrolled in the Order during June, July or August will be presented with a Knights of Columbus resery by the Supreme Council.

The rosary will be enclosed with a special message of congratulations and welcome from the supreme knight. Each rosary will be packaged and mailed automatically to the individual member after the membership document (Form #100) has been processed at the Supreme Council office.

Remember—it only takes about 10 minutes to say the rosary. Surely, this lan't too much time to return to God for the 1,440 minutes He gives us daily. And it isn't too big a price to pay for a truly Christian marriage, family life and for the cultivation of vocations.
