The Vision of Fr. McGivney

THE Knights of Columbus was founded on March 29, 1882, by Father Michael J. McGivney, curate at St. Mary's parish in New Haven, Conn.

As the priest explained to the small group of men gathered around him at a preliminary meeting in December 1881, his purpose in calling them together was manifold: to help the men and their families remain steadfast in their Catholic faith through mutual encouragement; to promote closer ties of fraternity among the men; and to set up an elementary system of insurance so that the widows and children of members in the group who might die would not find themselves in dire financial straits.

The founders and first officers of the fledgling organization chose the name "Knights of Columbus" because they felt that, as a Catholic group, it should relate to the Catholic discoverer of America. This would serve to point out that it was Catholics who discovered, explored and colonized the North American continent. At the same time "Knights" would signify that the membership embodied knightly ideals of spirituality and service to Church, country and fellowman.
