

What is *Aid and Support After Pregnancy?*

- For every \$500 a council or assembly donates to a pregnancy resource center or maternity home, Supreme will donate another \$100.
- **Limits:**
 - No cap on the # of centers/homes a council can support.
 - No cap on the # of councils a center/home can be supported by.
 - The max a center can receive from Supreme on behalf of one council is \$400 per fraternal year.
 - *Donations for ultrasound machines do not qualify.*

- *Don't forget to attach a W-9 from the center and either a donation receipt letter or copy of a cashed check*



Refund Support Vocation Program (RSVP)

- Purpose is to provide **DIRECT** support to seminarians or religious during their formation.
- For every **\$500** given to an individual, the Supreme Council will refund the council or assembly **\$100**
 - Novitiates **are** eligible for RSVP, not just Seminarians
 - SHMS Endowment Fund is **not** eligible for RSVP refunds
- RSVP refunds should be used as seed money for future vocations fund raising events
- Report RSVP using form #2863 along with supporting documentation - Due June 30th **NO PAPERWORK, NO REFUND, NO RECORD YOU DID IT!**






