All girls and boys ages 9 to 14 are invited to participate in the local level of competition for the year 2016-2017 Knights of Columbus Free Throw championship beginning at 5 pm. Sunday, Jan. 29 at St. Joseph Catholic Church, 830 S Lafayette, South Lyon.

Registration starts at 4:30 p.m.

All contestants on the local level are recognized for their participation in the event. The winners from each age group are eligible to participate in the District Free Throw competition to be held in February. The winners will advance through state competition. International champions are announced by the K of C international headquarters based on scores from the state-level competitions.

Since its beginning, over 2.5 million youths have participated in the annual competition.
